She noted that budget time was coming and relayed some information regarding the budget for the taskforce to consider when making their recommendations to the full Board. Snyder and Lister discussed waiting to have the next meeting until the fall (September or October) when the results from the school survey come back, agreeing that the taskforce would then have a better idea of how to use the settlement money, whether it be for education, drug court, or salaries for a Med/Seg nurse or case manager, or a combination of choices.
