Approval of Minutes

- I. [22-7091](#) Approval of February 17, 2022 Minutes
A motion was made by Comparato, seconded by Basden II, to approve the February 17, 2022 minutes as presented. The motion carried by unanimous vote.
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Old Business

- II. [22-7092](#) Med/Seg Unit
Rendleman questioned the plan updates for the Med/Seq unit. Rendleman commented that he felt the committee needed to pay attention to the procedural aspects of getting something built. Calandro commented that the committee was only voting to set aside the money and that the details would be dealt with at a later date. The committee had a discussion regarding whether the unit would be revenue generating, whether it would stabilize the population in the County, and finally decided to set aside \$2,163,650 for a Medical Segregation Unit at the Jackson County Jail.
A motion was made by Comparato, seconded by Snyder, to approve setting aside funding for the Med/Seq unit. The motion carried by the following vote:
