- I. [22-6849](#) Approval of November 16, 2021 Minutes

- II. [22-6850](#) Camera Requirements
Larkin and Cervantez led a discussion on whether the liquor ordinance should be updated to require cameras in the County licensed liquor establishments. The committee discussed the issue including camera placements and how long the footage should be saved. The committee agreed to have Cervantez create the update for the ordinance and the committee would vote at the next liquor meeting.
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New Business

- III. [22-6856](#) Manager or Supervising Agent Discussion
Larkin commented that the current liquor ordinance requires the manager of the liquor establishments to live in Jackson County and that he felt there should be a change in the language of the requirement. The committee discussed the topic briefly. Larkin, with agreement from the committee, asked Cervantez to update the ordinance to include language that the manager listed be approved by the Liquor commissioner with advice/consent of the liquor board. He asked that the ordinance change be ready to be voted on by the committee at the next liquor meeting.
