Approval of Minutes

I. 2024-140 Approval of November 6, 2023 Minutes

A motion was made by Basden, seconded by Snyder, to approve the November 6, 2023, minutes as presented. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Communication

Old Business

The County Administrator commented that she had taken the liquor truck item off of the agenda since it had been a year and no movement on the topic had happened. She asked the liquor board if they wanted to keep the item on future agendas and the consensus was to leave it off until the topic was brought up again. The County Administrator also asked the liquor board to begin thinking of whether they were interested in increasing liquor license fees for next year. She mentioned that next year's liquor application would be approved at the next meeting and that would be the time to make any changes they felt necessary to the application and license fees.

New Business

II. 2024-141 Approval of Life O Riley Venue, LLC Liquor License

A motion was made by Basden, seconded by Gale, to approve the Life O Riley Venue, LLC Liquor License. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

III. 2024-142 Shawnee Cave Liquor License

The liquor board had a long discussion regarding allowing the Shawnee Cave to sell liquor at any of their upcoming events. Gale mentioned that the owner had not met the minimum standards the health department requires, but she did point out that the owner has a temporary camping license with the health department and that campers would be allowed to bring their own liquor. After much discussion, the liquor board came to the consensus to have Calandro contact the owner to let him know that he would not be issued any kind of liquor license, including having a vendor come and sell it for events, until he met the standards required by the

health department. The owner still would be allowed to have camping setup, sell food, and have campers bring their own liquor.
