Shawnee was not present, but sent a report that the County Administrator shared with the Board and agencies.

Shawnee's update:

- At Shawnee Health-Murphysboro, starting on April 5, 2023 at 2pm, Tiffany A., LCPC will be running a SUD Group for 12 weeks using an evidence based program: Living in Balance manual from Hazelden Publishing.
 - Starting in May 2023, we will be adding another counselor, Molly Q. to the Shawnee Health-Murphysboro location to help increase behavioral health patient care at that location. She has an interest in working with youth and the LGBTQ+ population, which will be an asset for that location.
 - Two of our Jackson County Licensed staff are continuing their training from University of Michigan for Addictions Treatment Certification and plan to have that completed by June 2023.
