I. 2025-239 Approval of November 6, 2024, Minutes

II. 2025-240 Gaming Fee Increase for FY26

The County Administrator reviewed the gaming fee increase information that was included in the meeting packet. The liquor board had a lengthy discussion regarding their options to increase gaming fees for FY26. After discussion, the Board decided to raise the fee by \$100 to equal \$125 for each gaming device for FY26. A motion was made by Snyder, seconded by Cascio-Hale, to raise the FY26 Gaming Fee to \$125 per machine. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

III. 2025-241 Unique Expressions, LLC Application

A motion was made by Basden, seconded by Gale, to approve the Unique Expressions, LLC Application pending additional documentation of the Bassett training certificate of the current trained person and a second person needing to be Bassett trained with certification. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

IV. 2025-242 Club Coyote

Calandro reported that Club Coyote was shutting down, and that the Board staff would reach out to see when the establishment was closing and send a letter to request a return of the liquor license. A motion was made by Basden, seconded by Cascio-Hale to revoke Club Coyote's liquor license pending review by the Assistant State's Attorney for the date the lease is up. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.
